



Purpose

We will continue to build relationships with the students and encouraging them to have honest dialogue with each other and with Scripture. We meet in the youth house and split up middle school and high school into separate parts of the house. We have a team of gifted teachers who care about and love your kids. Our Bible-based curriculum from YM360 does a great job of encouraging conversation and we are looking forward to being able to dive deeper in these times.

Both middle school and high school will be doing a curriculum from YM360:

High school ➡ The Life: Embracing the life of a Christ-follower. This study will help high school students know what it means to live as authentic followers of Christ.

Middle school ➡ The Rescue: Discovering how the Gospel rescues and redeems us. This study will help middle school students see what a radical difference the Gospel makes in their lives and in the World.

Agenda

- 1 Opening-** We will ask a silly icebreaker and about their weeks to check in with them. This time is great as we build relationships with the students.
- 2 Lead in-** This will be a video, recap, or story of some sort to help us prepare for the lesson that week.
- 3 Main event-** This is the lesson. We will walk through the passage of Scripture. We will discuss things like the background, historical context, characters, and other important details. During this time we will also begin to see how it applies to our lives today.
- 4 Last word-** The lessons end with a challenge or a practical way to apply the lesson to our lives.
