The Mission

- Adult Discipleship Groups**
Join us to deepen your love for Jesus with adult discipleship programs built for everyone. We meet to support one another as the family of God with some “higher” learning. Spiritual growth happens when we “encourage one another and build one another up” in the context of Christ-centered relationships (1 Thess. 5:11).
- Children’s Ministry**
We seek to provide a safe, fun, Spirit-filled learning environment in which our children can develop a personal relationship with Jesus. Assistants are needed for the Nursery or JAM—care for infants or assist teachers, no prep required, serve once a month. Teachers—prep lesson and teach, training provided, serve once a month.
- HinGE**
Our mission is to introduce, instruct and empower members of NAPC to be a caring and loving congregation: equipped to be in Christian conversation, walking along side those who have suffered a significant loss. The HinGE team is always looking for those who feel called to learn more about what we do, and for those who would like to join our team as caregivers to those suffering from grief.
- Music Ministry**
At NAPC, our priority in musical worship and congregational singing is to glorify God by singing words that are true, and scripture based or inspired. Worship through song is a time for God to be praised, and our body of believers to be encouraged! There are multiple opportunities for you to share the musical gifts God has given you in our church.
- NAPC Life Team**
The NAPC Life Team will rely on God’s guidance to educate, inform, serve, and encourage our church and community to be gospel-driven champions of life. There are opportunities to sign up to learn more about being a gospel-driven champion of life and to volunteer in this ministry.
- NAPC Meal Train**
We are here to show the love of Christ to those who need it in the form of a meal. This is a unique ministry in that there are no meetings or time commitments. When there is a need for meals, the link for the meal sign-up is sent out to everyone on the team, and there are usually eight days that we take meals over a two-week period.
- Operations Committee**
Volunteers are needed to work in areas of maintenance, vendor/contractor relations and oversight, landscaping, event management, safety and security, opening and closing the building and special projects as they come up. Time needed is flexible but usually 2-4 hours a month is sufficient.
- Sunday Servants**
Flexible scheduling opportunities. Sunday morning Greeters meet the congregation with a smiling face, welcoming them for service & hand out bulletins. The Coffee Team will prepare pots of coffee for the congregation to self-serve before and after service. The Visitor Welcome team will answer questions and welcome our visitors. Our Team Lead will make sure everyone feels comfortable in their role and lend a hand as needed.
- 222 Youth Ministry**
At NAPC we want to reach and equip students with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Our hope is that every student in grades 7th through 12th are radically transformed by the Gospel and will equipped to then live out the lives that Jesus calls them to live. Adult volunteers are needed to lead and serve our students.

The Mission

- Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA)**
We seek to make disciples through our strategy of engaging, equipping and empowering coaches and athletes to know and grow in Christ and lead others to do the same. Volunteer opportunities include cooking and delivering meals—some specifically in Linden, or leading a discussion table with the athletes during the team huddle.
- Hope for Renewal (Idora)**
Hope for Renewal (H4R) is an EPC church plant in the Idora neighborhood of Youngstown (equivalent of our Linden community). H4R seeks to serve, build relationships and to share the love of Christ. In the summer of 2022 NAPC began to partner with this ministry by conducting mission trips to the Idora Community near Youngstown. Get involved by going on mission today!
- International Friendships (IFI)**
IFI serves international students studying at OSU offering many special events—Bible discussion groups, one on one discipleship & mentoring, English Conversation Partners, airport pickups and temporary housing for new students arriving, holiday meal hosting, and more!
- LifeWise Academy**
Many hands are needed to serve LifeWise New Albany's 220 students! As we prepare for the next school year, we need classroom volunteers and drivers. We also need classroom supplies as the teachers prepare lessons throughout the year.
- NAPC Life Team**
The NAPC Life Team will rely on God's guidance to educate, inform, serve, and encourage our church and community to be gospel-driven champions of life. Volunteer to support ministry partners in the areas of Parenting, Adoption and Foster Care by providing time and resource to further their missions.
- Out of Darkness/Frontline Response**
Out of Darkness is on the frontlines everyday rescuing individuals from sex trafficking. Volunteers are needed for Princess Night, a street ministry in downtown Columbus on Friday nights. Other ministry opportunities such as rescue teams, hot line call response, and drop-in center require additional training. Donations of women's clothing and toiletries are welcome!
- RESET**
To help fulfill the Great Commission among public school students in Columbus Ohio. Volunteers in this ministry begin by praying for the students, their families and their schools. You can volunteer as an assistant or teacher.
